When hearing the first reading from Ecclesiastes this Sunday, the words can snap our minds and hearts to attention: "Vanity of vanities, says Qoheleth, vanity of vanity! All things are vanity" (Ecc. 1:2)! That word translated "vanity" in English comes from a Hebrew word meaning "breath or vapor." We can fear these words from Scripture, because so much of our efforts flow from faith, hope and love. Families are raised with great sacrifice and care, work provides for loved ones, schooling garners insights and prepares us for careers, friendships warm our hearts, and the beauty of laughter and fond memories fill us with thanksgiving. How can all this be "vapor" or "vanity"? Yet, secretly, have we not all, in perhaps a trying season of our life, wondered what it is "all about"? The toil, the heartache, the pain, and troubles that accompany the sweet things in life, do we need to blind ourselves from these experiences? In this, Jesus offers a key to help unlock something of this mystery.

In the Gospel today (Lk. 12:13-21), Jesus meets a man who wants his brother to share his inheritance with him. Instead of supporting that man's efforts to have his brother give his "fair share," Jesus offers a parable of caution. The older brother may be greedily holding onto his possessions, but do not envy his possessions and fight greed with greed. Rather, store up treasure in heaven. As St. Paul writes to the Colossians: "If you were raised with Christ, seek what is above" (Col. 3:1). When our hearts look to even good things on this side of eternity for our full satisfaction, we will experience their vaporous quality. Health wanes, good families experience hurt, our careers do not always pan-out as we would hope, and so on. We cannot hang the hats of our satisfaction on the frail hooks of life's passing splendor. Instead, we must go deeper.

The first reading and the Gospel today move us into a place of gratitude for the gifts of life without trying to cling to them too tightly. God does bless us, and we can enjoy those blessings with joy and thanksgiving. But, every good thing we encounter carries only a promise, a seed of eternity. If we idolize these good gifts, we will soon discover their misty dissipation. However, if we take Jesus' words into our hearts, we will carry on with grateful hearts that keep longing for the promise to come in its fullness in heaven. We won't be overly troubled when life ushers in disappointments, because we know our fulfillment only comes through Jesus Christ and with Him in heaven. This does not diminish the beauty of creation; rather, it sets it in proper order and so our lives can flow towards the heaven Jesus promises with every kiss of grace we receive in this life.
