I ask you to pray for us during this time that God will continue to bless this parish with great workers in the vineyard as He has over these 75 years!

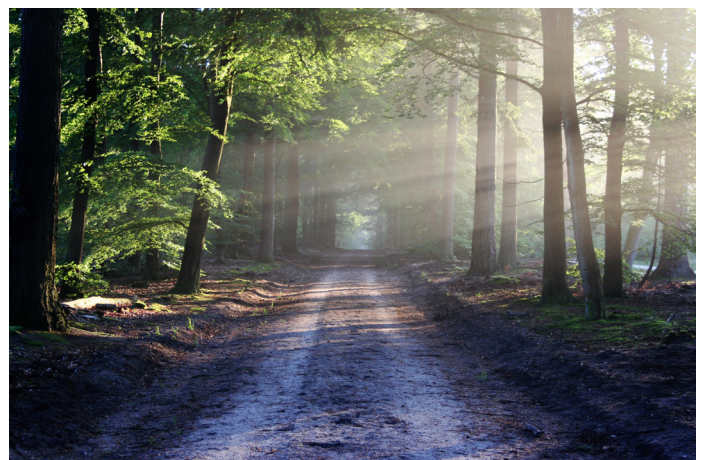
