It is amazing to see how our children benefit from the selflessness of your love.

Going back to my trip to Manchester High School. When I entered the property, I caught sight of their sign which has led me to much prayer over the last few days: “The road to success is always under construction.” This is true on so many levels. We are a work in progress. There is much work to be done – mostly within the depths of our hearts. Sometimes we can fall into despair when the troubles of life can overwhelm us. In those times, remember the words of Jesus: “Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid.” Know that Jesus is with you. He calls you to keep working, to keep going – believing that success will come if you keep your eyes fixed on Him.

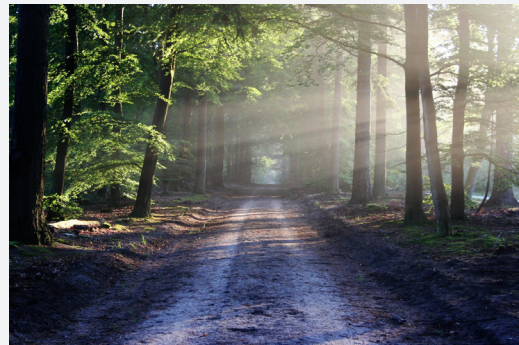
