So let's keep working in our church Until the resurrection, And then we each will join God's Church Without an imperfection.

Let's continue to share this gift with the world! Where do we go from here? As we head toward the next 75 years of parish life here at St. Francis de Sales, let us take to heart the words of St. Francis de Sales. These words were found on the back of Fr. Diederich's Funeral Card...Have Courage..."Do not look forward to what might happen tomorrow; the same everlasting Father who cares for you today will take care of you tomorrow and every day. Either He will shield you from suffering or He will give you unfailing strength to bear it. Be at peace, then, and put aside all anxious thoughts and imaginations."

After much prayer and study, he established the Avilas of the Diocese of Cleveland. Bishop Anthony Pilla designed the logo for this newly established ministry. In 1996, Fr. Schleicher initiated a parish Avila Prayer group here at St. Francis. He led the first Holy Hour, assisted by Richard Butz (before he became a deacon). In the 27 years of Holy Hours for Vocations, led mostly by our Deacons, we've seen many new vocations coming from our beloved parish. Prayer can move mountains! #### WINTER CLOTHING DRIVE & BLANKET SUNDAY


October 7th & 8th
