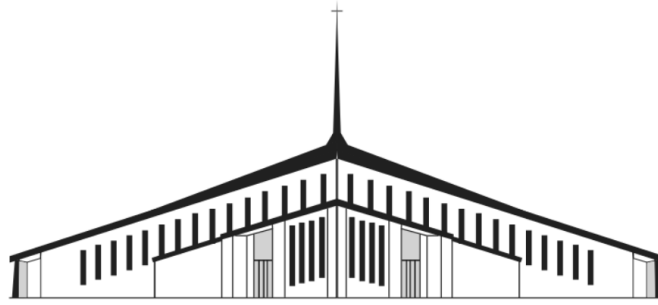
If your second grade student does not attend our parish school and you plan on having them receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion this year, they need to be registered for PSR.

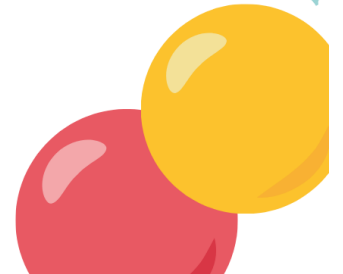
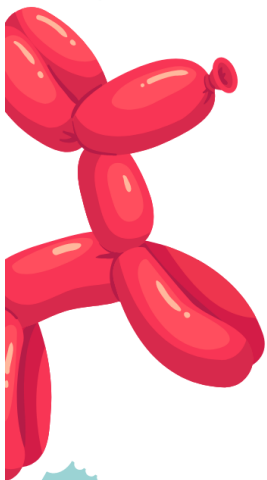
