HEARING LOOP



St. Francis de Sales Church is equipped with an active Hearing Loop System. This system can enhance your worship experience if you have a hearing aid with an activated tele-coil

(T-coil). Please be sure that your hearing aid with an activated tele-coil is on the correct setting. If you are unsure if your hearing aid has a tele-coil, contact your audiologist to inquire. Each section of pews in the main church area has been wired for the hearing loop. The following are tips to maximize the hearing loop experience with an active tele-coil in your hearing aid:

- 1. Sit toward the front of the pew sections. This ensures proximity to the hearing loop wires; therefore, the signal is stronger.
- 2. Sit toward the end of the pew closer to the aisle. This additionally ensures you are closer to the hearing loop wires since the hearing loop wires are where the carpet and tile meet.
