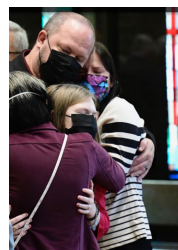

Jesus is speaking to the crowds and His disciples. He is challenging them to not be like the scribes and pharisees—that it is not enough to merely talk about the faith. 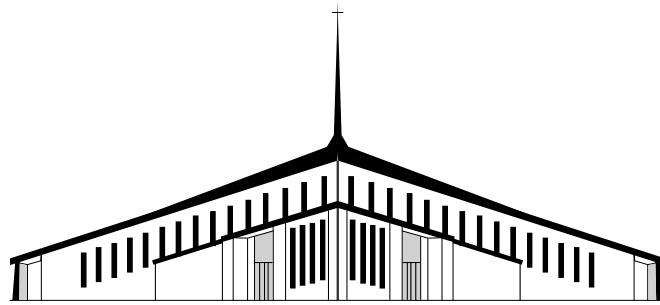
