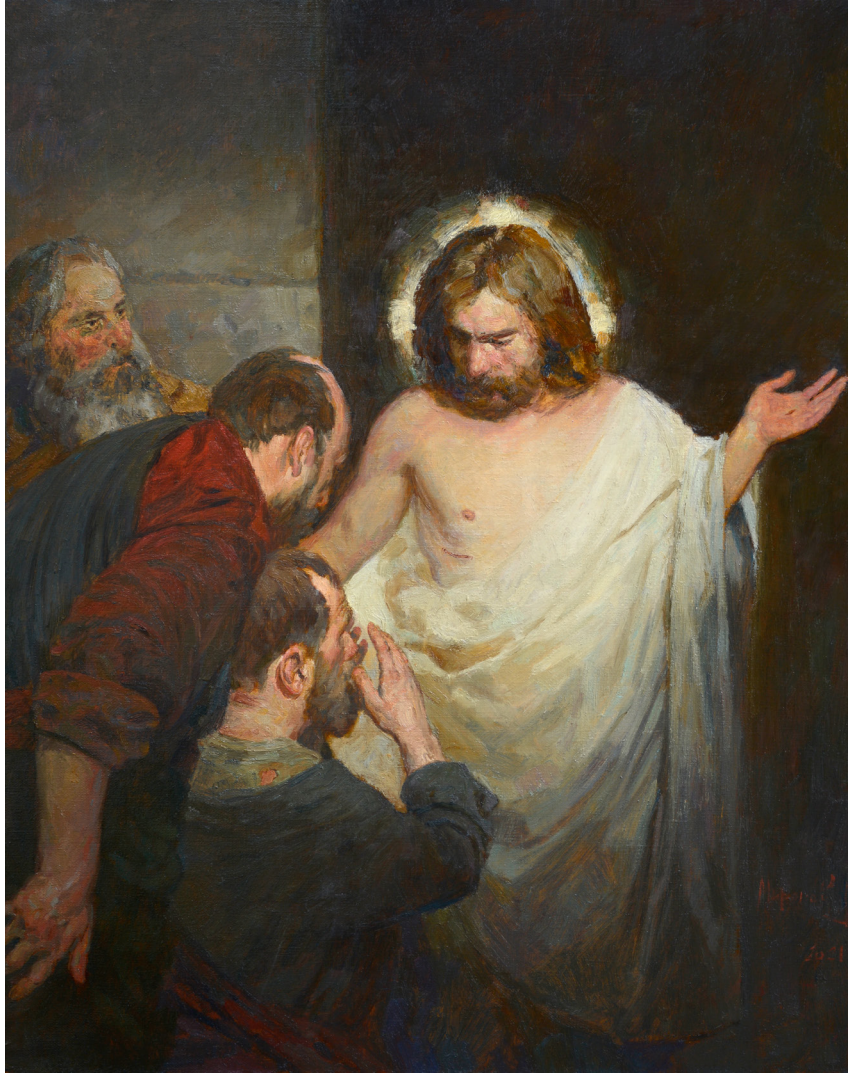

**DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**



"Peace be with you." I am always blown away by these first words of Jesus to His disciples as He appeared to them for the first time since the Resurrection. "Peace be with you."
