



...WHERE THERE IS DESPAIR, HOPE...

Just last month, we had our first Parish Council (PC) meeting of the year. If you weren't aware of it, Bishop Malesic issued a new vision for PC throughout the diocese. He is inviting us to allow a big chunk of the meeting time to be prayer so, that as we allow the Holy Spirit to move in our hearts, we can listen to how God wants us to respond in mission and ministry. You may have also noticed that there was no voting for new members. The new guidelines have taken away the option to vote for members. Rather, PC will nominate potential members and then prayerfully discern who the new members will be. We are stepping into this new approach, and it is working well. We do welcome new members Matthew Crawford, Rick Evans and Michelle Jackson. We also thank Logan Tolson who has completed his service. If you want to learn more about the Diocese of Cleveland Parish Council guidelines, they are published on the diocesan website.

Why do I bring up Parish Council in this bulletin article? Precisely because the topic is HOPE. ...Where there is despair, hope... One of the questions I asked PC members to pray with and answer was: "What is your hope for St. Francis de Sales Parish?" I sprung the question on them and only gave them a couple minutes to pray on it, then we went around the room. Their answers were fantastic! What are their hopes? Here you go! 1) Familiarity with the Sacraments – families that frequent the Sacraments; 2) Grow as a family and deepen relationships with one another; 3) Increase faith-sharing with others; 4) Continue to grow as a parish; 5) Have full Mass attendance; 6) Be of good service to others and know the needs of the community; 7) Fall in love with Jesus (that was mine! 😊); 8) Increase our welcoming presence; 9) Make church a safer place for prayer; 10) Grow enrollment at the school; 11) Do a better job of welcoming PSR families into the community; 12) Enhance our ability to embrace others into our community by sincere invitation.

What is your hope for the parish? I am writing this a couple days before the PC shares and prays with your thoughts and concerns that they gathered this past weekend. I look forward, with the help of God, to making St. Francis de Sales a place where hope dwells.



This year, Bishop Malesic is asking that every parish participate in the Diocesan Week of Service from March 22-28. He wrote this... "Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Some time ago, I wrote you a pastoral letter entitled 'A Flourishing Apostolic Church.' It was there that I asked you to follow a pastoral blueprint to examine the ways we worship, evangelize, and serve. Today, I am inviting you to consider putting the third leg of this blueprint into action by taking part in the Diocesan Week of Service from March 22-28, 2026. Parishes, schools, and Catholic organizations are invited to host a service opportunity during the Week of Service. You know the needs of your community better than we do, so we are asking you to design a project that suits the needs of your local community."

Our parish staff brainstormed that the Week of Service would not be a single project, but rather we would invite all families to go out into the community and perform random acts of service and kindness. This could be as simple as writing a card or letter to someone, helping someone paint a room or clean a house, or even doing spring yardwork for someone else. I will leave this up to each family.

Since it is the Year of St. Francis, we thought we would put a Franciscan spin on this opportunity. St. Francis of Assisi interpreted God's command to "Rebuild My Church" not just as repairing physical buildings, but as a call to restore the "living stones" – the human members of the Body of Christ. Inspired by 1 Peter 2:5, he knew believers are spiritual stones that must be renewed, repaired, and brought back to the center of the Church's mission through love and service. In the spirit of St. Francis, you and your family are invited to pick up a small stone provided by the parish at Sunday Mass on March 22 and take it home with you. Then, find a way to be of service during the week. Afterward, you can paint your family name on the stone and return it the following Sunday, March 29. Then we will use them to make something beautiful in the butterfly garden. Every stone will represent an act of service by a family, and every act of service builds up the Body of Christ. Thank you for joining in our mission to "Rebuild the Church!"

The generosity of St. Francis de Sales Parish is unbelievable. Thank you! Our shelves are filling up quickly with just one week to go in our Third Annual SVdP Food Drive. These food items will help nourish many families in the coming weeks.

We simply ask for a couple items you may use in your own homes or at your family dinner table. Please bring these items to the narthex when you come to the weekend Masses. As you drop off your donation, please say a prayer for the neighbor you are giving hope to. Our final week, we are asking for the following, but if you missed a week and still would like to donate other items you have, it is never too late to feed the hungry.

March 21/March 22: Paper products (toilet paper, tissues, paper towels)

If it is difficult for you to shop and transport items, a monetary donation is always welcome to help our neighbors through rough times. We will share stories in the coming weeks of how we have helped – through your monetary generosity – families with everything from furniture to medicine to utility bills. There are specific SVdP envelopes in the pamphlet stand in the narthex that you may use and drop in the collection basket. Also we have a SVdP collection box in the back of the narthex by the usher's room.

At St. Francis de Sales, the three pillars of Lent – Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving – are certainly being lived. Thanks to your Lenten sacrifices, our pantry feeds our local neighbors. Last fiscal year, we had 208 visits from people in Zip Code 44319, 95 from 44314, and 57 from 44203.




