God is providential! Just last November, during my annual retreat, I was drawn to pray with the book called *Coming to Life: Being Baptized by the Holy Spirit*, by Fr. Robert DeGrandis. During that time, the Holy Spirit was inviting me and challenging me to bring this renewal of the Holy Spirit to the parish somehow, someday. Then, in a matter of weeks, I received the phone call about Immaculate Conception Parish. When I was researching what the parish did on their website, I saw that at some point, they offered a *Life in the Spirit* seminar for parishioners. This spurred me on to consider further what we can offer here at St. Francis de Sales that will help us get a clearer sense of what the Holy Spirit is doing in our lives and desires for us. Finally, this year of St. Francis of Assisi took to me to Franciscan, Fr. Dave Pivonka TOR who created the awesome series called "The Wild Goose." This is a 14-part series that helps us discover a deeper relationship with the Holy Spirit. Each video is roughly 25-30 minutes and covers different aspects of the Holy Spirit's workings in our lives. These 7:00 p.m. Tuesday evening gatherings in the Memorare Center will start on June 2 and go till August 25. Every week, we will learn about the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The plan is simply to watch a video each meeting and have a heart-felt discussion after. I may spice up the discussion with insights from other books I have read on the Holy Spirit too. We need to give the Holy Spirit more space in our lives and give God more chances to transform our lives. Can you give Him an additional hour each week this summer? In the Acts of the Apostles this weekend, the apostles chose those *filled* with the Holy Spirit to help them continue to build up the Body of Christ and serve the community. 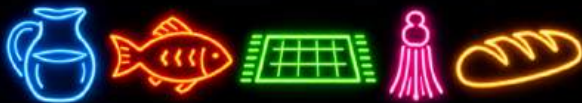

MISSION TRIP REFLECTION

Parishioner Kevin Elliot, a first-year student at Ohio State University, recently participated in a FOCUS mission trip to Peru with the Buckeye Catholic campus ministry. His trip was funded in part by contributions from our parishioners. He wrote the following reflection on his experience.

First and foremost, I would like to express my deepest gratitude for the support you have shown me with your support for my trip. The lessons I learned and encounters I experienced were made possible because of your generosity. That said, you may not know what exactly I took part in as part of this trip. Over Spring Break, I was fortunate enough to visit Pamplona, Peru. This community experiences widespread poverty, as it essentially is the exiled population of Lima who were forced to move into the mountains. The population currently stands at around 20,000 people, yet the government has all but abandoned these people in terms of their needs. Our "job" was to build a water retention wall to reduce the damage that flooding does during the rainy season. Coming into the trip, my expectation of where I would find meaning and God's purpose for my attendance was in the idea that we may have a major impact on the quality of living for the people of Pamplona. However, two factors have changed my perspective on this situation. The first is the work we put in was a drop in the bucket of what would leave a lasting impact. The simple truth is that with such a large population and only a few days, the work we did is simply a contribution to many years of hard labor. That said, our presence was not at all in vain. One of the missionaries in Buckeye Catholic explained the true meaning of our mission – that is, to love those around us. Though this certainly extended to all age groups, the children were most heavily impacted by this idea. Much of the time spent while not doing work was simply used to play with the children. This simple act of spending time with these children and helping them to play sports brought so much joy to both them and us. God was present for me throughout the entire trip, through the interactions of others, the fulfilling work, and the dedicated hours of spending time close to God. His outpouring of grace over this week is something I know will remain with me for years to come, shaping my identity in Him.
